


# 1971 Rockville Library

99 Maryland Avenue (demolished)



The 1971 Rockville Library was the city's first permanent dedicated library structure. It was designed by area architect, Stanley A. Arthur, in the International Style. Characteristic elements included horizontality, continuous bands of window and brick, cantilevered sections supported by pilotis, and an emphasis on volume over mass. The property is now occupied by a new building housing the Maryland State District Courthouse.
