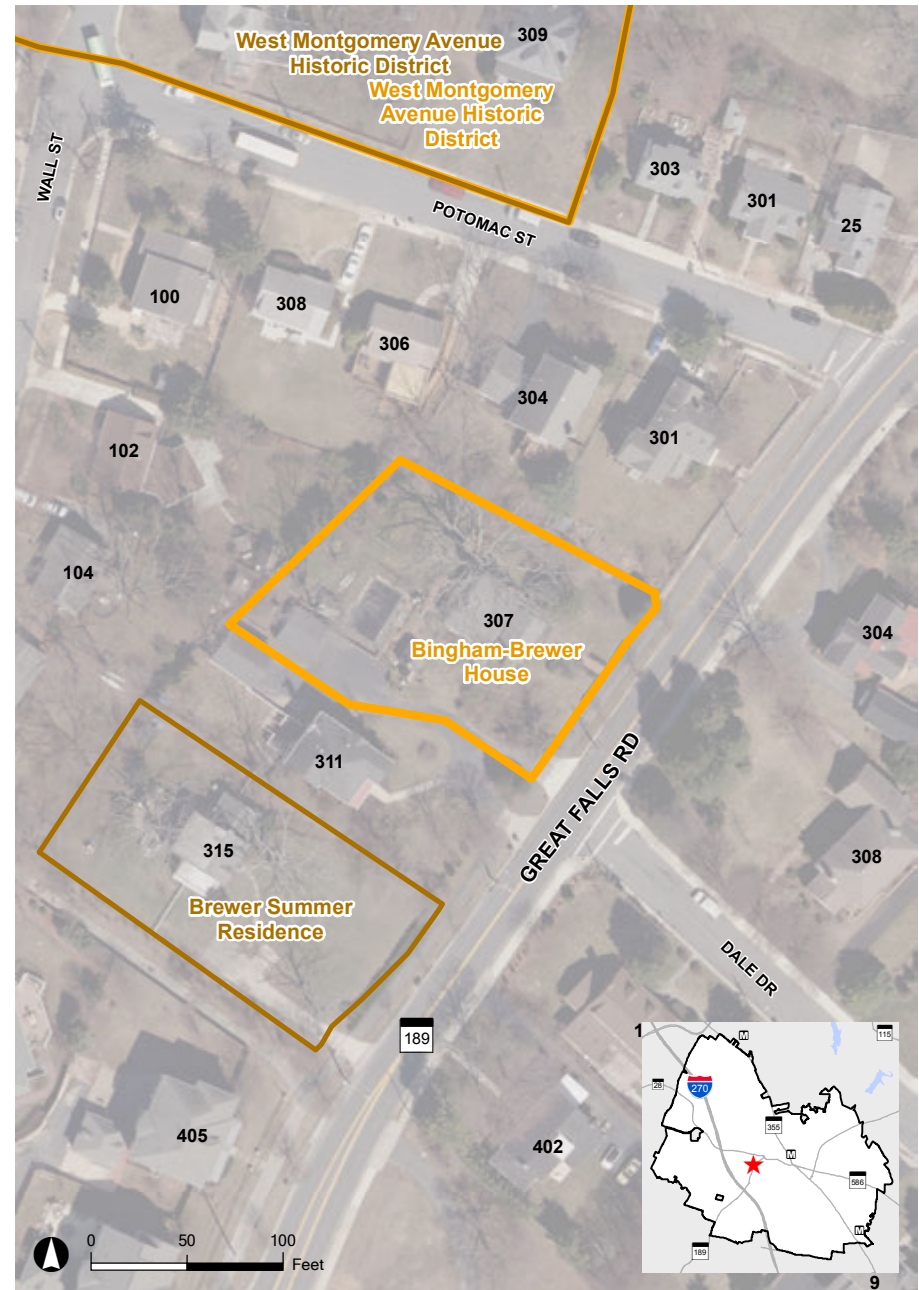


Bingham-Brewer House

307 Great Falls Road



The Bingham-Brewer House, built in 1821, is one of the oldest buildings in Rockville. It is a substantial brick Federal style house, associated with people who have exercised leadership roles in the city. Julius Bingham, editor of the second Rockville paper, William McClenahan, organizer of Rockville Christian Church, members of the Veirs family (local landholders), and members of the Brewer family (attorneys influential in local politics) have all lived here.
