

# Carey and Hattie Kingdom House

300 Reading Avenue



This Victorian frame house was built ca. 1893 in Rockville Park subdivision on the east side of the B & O railroad tracks. The property originally consisted of three lots, and from 1911 - 1971, it was owned by members of the Kingdom family ( first Carey and Hattie Kingdon, and then by Carey's sister, Mary R. Kingdon). The Victorian house features strong cross gables with decorative shingles in the gable ends, and covered cornices on south and east facades.
