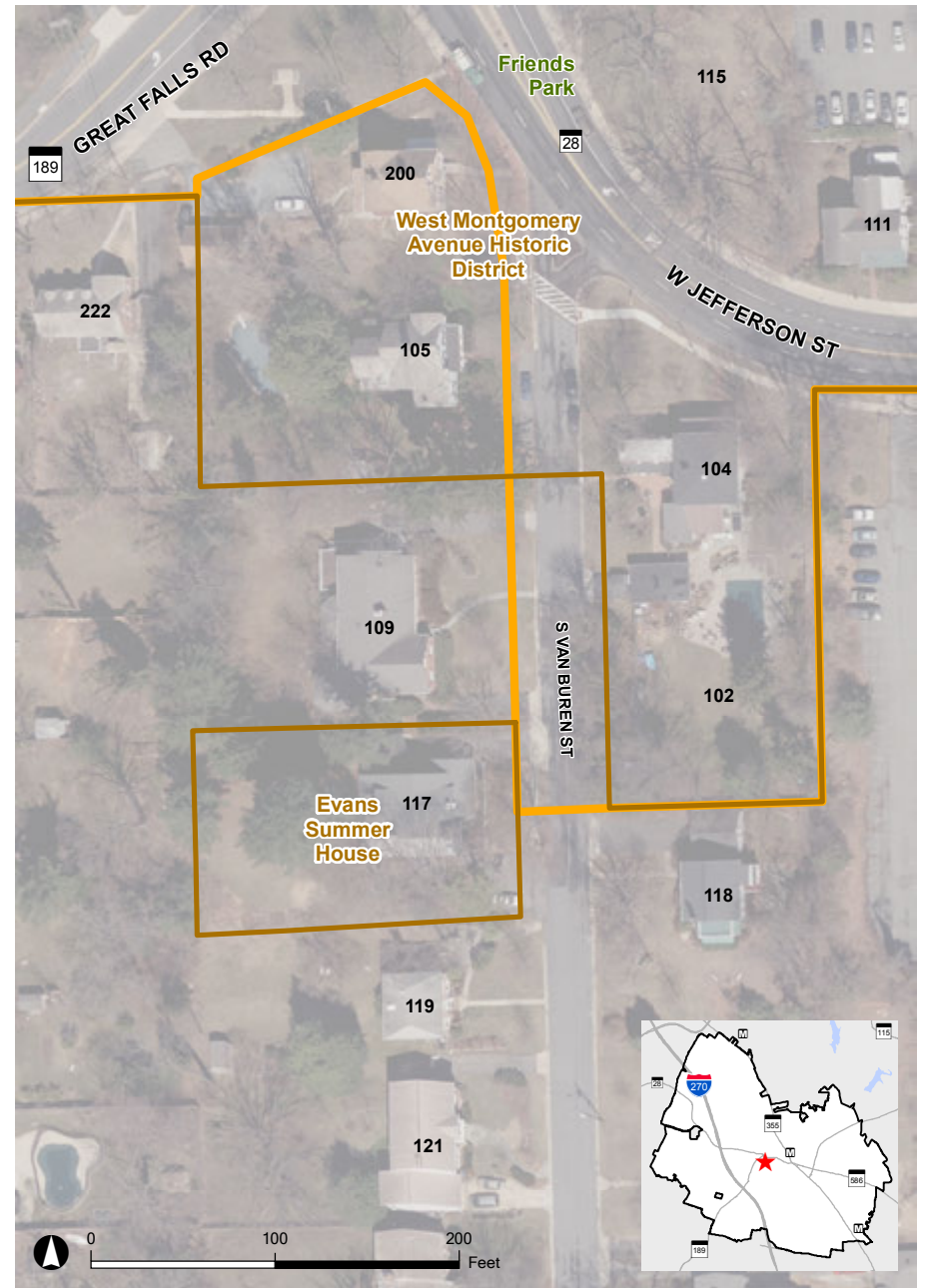


Evans Summer House

117 S. Van Buren Street



The Evans Summer House is a bungalow style frame house, which illustrates the expansion of Rockville in the 20th century. At the time it was constructed in 1923, the Evans family lived here from April through November and Mr. Evans commuted by streetcar into the District. However, in the winter months, they moved into the Roosevelt Hotel downtown to avoid the commute.
