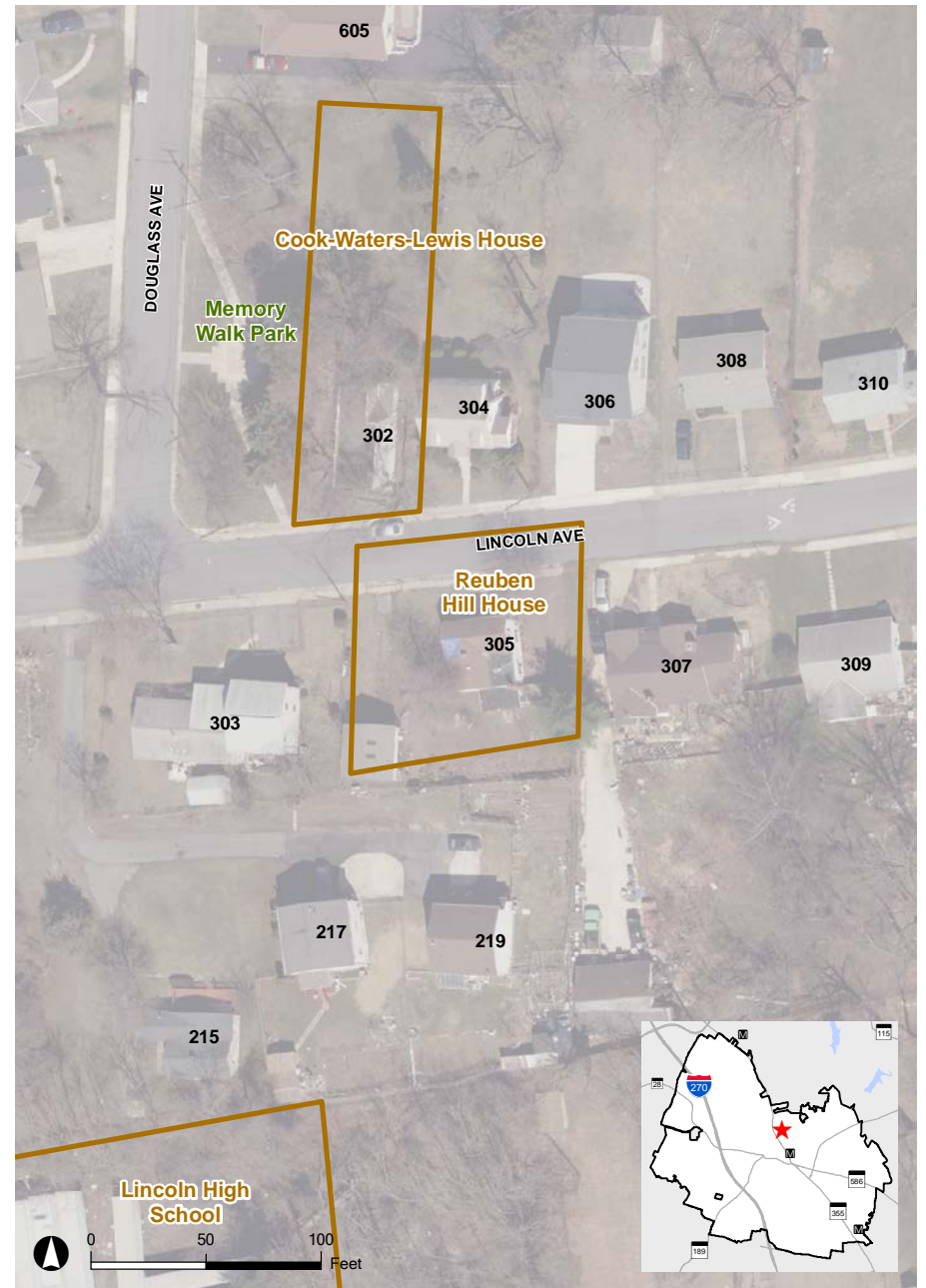


Reuben Hill House

305 Lincoln Avenue



The Reuben Hill House was the home to four generations of the Hill Family, early African-American settlers in Lincoln Park. Reuben Hill served as a slave to the Stonesteet Family until the Civil War. His wife, Rachel Martin, was not enslaved so their children were free. The original house has been enlarged to the current vernacular Farmhouse style with decorative spindlework on the front porch. There are several outbuildings and the original well in the back yard.
